In 2024, the Vendée Globe Foundation was born out of a desire to anchor the Vendée Globe in an essential mission: to take action to better protect the oceans.

At the crossroads of sport, economics, and science, the Endowment Fund is composed of a committed Board of Directors and a renowned Scientific Council, which guarantee the quality and relevance of the projects supported. We are also delighted to have H.S.H. Prince Albert II of Monaco as our Honorary President. With the help of our project manager and the support of more than 100 volunteers mobilized during the 2024 Vendée Globe, we have brought our actions closer to the public and our partners.

Thanks to the support of our 20 patrons, three projects have been supported this year:

- In partnership with UNESCO and the IMOCA Class, 25 skippers have taken scientific equipment on board to collect valuable data during their round-the-world voyage.
- With the Share the Ocean Consortium, which has mapped marine protected areas to limit collisions with marine wildlife.
- With Over the Swell, to protect marine megafauna, including the whale shark, the world's largest fish and an endangered species.

This first year has laid a solid foundation. It shows that combining sport, science, and collective commitment is not only possible, but above all necessary. The ocean is vital to our future: let's continue to work together to better preserve it.

OUR VALUES

THE OCEAN IS THE "BLUE LUNG" OF OUR PLANET

The ocean plays a role as important as the forests for our atmosphere! It produces 50% of the oxygen we breathe and stores 50% of the CO2 on our planet. We would be unable to breathe without it.



THE OCEAN IS CRUCIAL TO OUR LIVES

3.5 billion people depend on it as their primary source of food! The ocean covers more than 70% of our planet and accounts for 97% of the water available on Earth! In other words, we are all affected by the ocean.

THE OCEAN IS A KEY FI EMENT OF INNOVATION

It is an invaluable source of wealth: the ocean is fertile ground for the development of more sustainable energies, biotechnologies, and even medical advances.



MARINE BIODIVERSITY IS REMARKABLE

The ocean is a rich environment for ecosystems. Only 200,000 marine species are known to date, and if we do not protect them, half could disappear by 2100 and the ocean could contain more plastic than fish by 2050!

MORE SPECIFICALLY, THE VENDÉE GLOBE FOUNDATION SUPPORTED THREE MAJOR SCIENTIFIC PROJECTS IN 2024-2025.



01. INITIATIVE WITH UNESCO AND THE IMOCA CLASS

- **25/40 skippers** in the 2024 Vendée Globe voluntarily took scientific instruments on board.
- 100% of this equipment was deployed (11 Argo floats, 13 weather buoys, 5 Calitoos, 4 OceanPacks, 2 TSG Gaillard, Argo Marget II, planctoscope).
- ▶ Thousands of data points are collected, up to 5 years after deployment. For example, in 75 days of racing, Nicolas Lunven collected nearly 1.8 million data points with his OceanPack!
- ▶ This system enables the expansion of cooperative science through data sharing between scientific centers (GEOMAR, CNRS, Ifremer), then freely accessible via a global database managed by UNESCO.

Amount allocated: €15,000 (UNESCO) 2028 goal: to equip 100% of the fleet


02. WILLIAM MISSION

During the oceanographic mission we supported:

- 12 whale sharks were tagged and 20 divers were trained.
- Several schools in Finistère and Guinea benefited from educational workshops on the importance of protecting marine megafauna.
- The more data we have on whale sharks, the world's largest fish and an endangered species, the more arguments we have for implementing concrete measures to ensure their survival.

Amount allocated: €20,000 (Over the Swell) 2030 goal: to create the world's first protected offshore corridor

03. PROJECT WITH THE CONSORTIUM SHARE THE OCEAN

- 11 areas of vigilance identified based on a map of important cetacean breeding and feeding areas.
- **Biodiversity Protection** (BPAs) off-limits to skippers on the Vendée Globe route, under penalty of sanctions.
- The aim was to minimize the risk of collisions between boats and marine wildlife. On the New York-Vendée race, no collisions with marine animals were recorded thanks to this system!

Amount allocated: €31,200 (Banyuls Design) Objective: To reconcile the requirements of the yacht race, the choices made by the race management, and the need to protect marine ecosystems in the long term




OUR FINANCIAL STATEMENT



PORTION ALLOCATED TO OUR SHARES

As part of our launch year, nearly 60% of our budget was allocated to the projects we supported this year and to our awareness-raising activities. This share is set to grow in the coming years, in line with our purpose.



Launch costs cover legal setup, graphic design, logo, and trademark registration for the Vendée Globe Foundation.

Operating costs include general, legal, accounting, business, and salary expenses. Communication costs relate to updating the website and communication materials, as well as communication and event activities.

Support for scientific projects and awareness-raising activities complete the budget.

This breakdown includes cash expenditures and skills sponsorship.
